What is a *quinceañera*?

I have a Latina friend who is planning her daughter's *quinceañera*. It's as if she's planning a wedding. Please explain.

Quinceañera (keen-seh-ah-NYAIR-ah) is Spanish for "fifteen-year-old girl." It's also the word used for the Latin American celebration of a girl's entrance into young adulthood on her fifteenth birthday.

Some people compare it to an American Sweet 16 party, but because a religious ceremony is part of the celebration it's actually more like a thirteen-year-old girl's bat mitzvah in the Jewish tradition.

A *quinceañera* usually begins with a rite called the Order for the Blessing on the Fifteenth Birthday (*Bendición al cumplir quince años*), which can take place within or outside Mass. A party that resembles a wedding reception follows, so you make a good comparison when you say your friend seems to be planning a wedding. A *quinceañera* can also be like a wedding celebration in that some weddings get out of hand and become more of a production than a celebration of love.

That's not to say that parties aren't important. It's important to celebrate a wedding and to celebrate it well. In the same way, it's important in some cultures to celebrate a girl's fifteenth birthday. Your friend wants to give thanks to God for the life of her daughter, and that surely is a wonderful thing to celebrate.
